January Minutes

Principal's Report

- Mrs. Jordan investigated the fridge situation. The application for a grant for funds for a fridge was made by the PAC and the grant money was deposited into the Bradner account. The money was used for the staff room fridge which is where the fruit and veggies are stored and distributed by staff. It was never PAC money, it was Bradner Elementary money. Mrs. Jordan says we can purchase a fridge if we want one and we will need to work together to find a safe spot for it. We would like to not talk about this again.
- Thank you for the book money. The staff are in the process of looking at books to order – a combination of levelled sets and sets of 6 of the same books to teach multiple students. They are planning to use the \$1500 for books this year and then look at purchasing furniture for the learning commons for next year.

Stacey will check if we have enough bingo supplies. We will play some slide shows at bingo night. We discussed having a kids area. Stacey will ask Value Village for baskets
