May Minutes

- Motion to accept May's minutes made by Amanda, 2nd by Kori, all in favour

Treasurer's Report

- Melissa and Stacey counted the May Day money - we earned approximately \$2000 with May Day. This is a severe reduction from previous years due to the rain. We will need to cut back some of our expenditures this year
- Gaming grant - Stacey is in the process of this application
- Kori is going to look into how we can get our GST returned because we are a non-profit organization

Principals Report

- Thank you for the teacher's lunch
- The school has booked an artist to do a mural and some workshops with the kids - Jay Havens. He may do some more artwork in the fall with the kids.
- We have 10 kids from Reimer coming to help with sports day and the staff is wondering if PAC provide lunch for them.
- The school purchased a griddle for the barbecue to make pancakes for the pancake breakfast
- Options for PAC support next year include tennis lessons, a roller skating day and a dance teacher - all part of the physical education program. Mr. Marsh is trying to include other forms of dance in addition to the Maypole dancing as part of the Physical Education Program
- Also Mrs. Jordan has asked if we will continue to support the things that we did last year - planners, reading bike, turkey trot, Christmas skate, sports day pizzas, etc. - she asked the PAC to look at our budget for next year and advise the school of what we would like to support
- The Garden - we need to set up a schedule for garden watering volunteers for the summer - Mrs. Jordan will do the last week of August.
- Mrs. Jordan does not think any teachers are leaving. Mrs. Baker will be covering for Mrs. Goertzen until December.

Immediate Funding Opportunities and Voting

- Elections : The positions for next year's PAC executive is as follows:
 - 1) Chair – Kori Wall
 - 2) Vice Chair – Amanda McAllister
 - 3) Volunteer Coordinator – Melissa Yoemans
 - 3) Secretary – Tamara Arden
 - 4) Treasurer – Stacey Stinson

All executive positions have remained the same (with a switch between the Chair and vice chair positions) due to lack of interest from other parents and a willingness to continue serving by the 2018/2019 PAC executive.

- Constitution: Motion to accept the new constitution requiring 4 people to vote including at least 2 PAC executives made by Amanda, 2nd by Kori, majority in favor; motion passed.
- Reading program – Motion to provide up to \$300 to buy prizes for the reading program for next year made by Amanda, 2nd by Kori, majority in favor; motion passed
- Meet the teacher barbecue and coffee and snacks for first day of school – Motion to provide up to \$250 to pay for food for the meet the teacher barbecue in September and for donuts and coffee for the first day of school made by Amanda, 2nd by Tamara – majority in favor; motion passed.

Other Business

- May Day update – We made \$2000 which is much less than previous years due to the rain and expenditures were slightly more than usual due to it being the 100 year anniversary.
- Sports Day – Kori will be running the concession for May Day. She will send out a sign-up sheet. Tamara will write a donation request to Tim Horton's for coffee, donuts and muffins as requested by Deborah who has a family member who works for Tim Horton's
- Movie Night Recap - There was a good turnout for movie night.
- Lunch for year-end field trip - Pizza is being donated, the school is buying watermelon, cookies are donated and Kori is donating iced tea.
- Summer meeting – this will be held at someone's house in August. The date is to be determined.
- Game paintings - The painter has contacted us and she is concerned about the longevity of the paint that was used so she has extended a 5 year guarantee for the paintings (damage beyond normal wear and tear) and will redo them or repair them as necessary.
