April Minutes

Treasurer's Report

- Stacey will apply for the 2019/2020 gaming grant this month
- We spent \$18000 this year and have brought in approximately \$8000 so far.
- Stacey is going to look into how we can get our GST returned because we are a non-profit organization

Immediate Funding Opportunities and Voting

- Gifts for Departing staff – Motion to provide up to \$100 for departing staff made by Melissa, 2nd by Kori, majority in favor – motion passed
- Mayday supplies – Motion to provide \$294.23 to reimburse Stacey for plates, cups, napkins and cutlery made by Kori, 2nd by Tamara, majority in favor – motion passed

Other Business

- May Day update – Stacey and Kori went shopping at Surdel Party Rentals in Surrey and got some good deals on serving ware for May Day. Melissa gave out posters for volunteers to take and post in the community in the next week. Melissa was able to get 5 volunteers from Rick Hansen. Tamara will ask the church if we can borrow the tables. We are going to follow a layout similar to last year's. The clown has been booked and we will be selling balloon animals/objects. Taline got a ride sponsor for \$500 for the bouncy counsel. We will ask Ms. Jordan to open up May Day on the stage. Amanda will also give a little talk. Ms. Jordan's son's band has offered to play but we have to figure out the set up and requirement for a sound system. Amanda will talk to Ms. Jordan about the logistics on Monday. Ryan can play as well. Kori has made 240 cupcakes and her sister in laws have made about 200. The rest of the people at the meeting will also make some cupcakes for the cupcake walk. We asked parents to donate to the bake sale this year instead of the cupcake walk so that we can have a good bake sale. Stacey will be at the school on Friday setting up. Tamara and Faye will be at the hall on Sunday night setting up for the pancake breakfast. Tamara will contact Niki for access to the hall. The order will be dignitary speeches, Maypole, then races – potato sack, wheel barrel and

sprints. Melissa bought sacks from Trading Post that may work. Melissa will get float candy and candy for Maypole dancers and prizes or candy for race winners

- Sports Day – there will be a concession on Sports day as well as hot lunch. Sports day is scheduled for Friday June 21st.
- Year-end waterpark field trip day lunch – Amanda will order the pizza for the lunch and we will discuss this further at the next meeting.
- Teacher's Lunch/appreciation day/week – we will be hosting a lunch this year and this is scheduled for Friday June 7th. We will be doing a taco bar and Apple crisp for dessert. Melissa will bring beef. Tamara will do Tomatoes, onions, lettuce and salsa, Amanda will bring shredded chicken, Stacey is doing shells and sour cream, Kori is doing cheese and drinks.
- Changes to Constitution – the suggestion is that we change the constitution to need 4 people to vote including 2 PAC executives, but leaving the other two people open (can be either PAC executive or non-executive members Tamara will look at it and we can vote on it at the next meeting.
- Discussion on elections for PAC executive and how to increase interest and attendance at meetings. We will talk positively about it and try to make the PAC fun.
